### FAQ'S (Frequently Asked Questions)

#### Subject: "Principal answered FAQ's"

1. When will the school reopen?

As on today, the school will reopen after 15<sup>th</sup> August 2020.

- 2. When will the classes start?
  - Classes will start after 15<sup>th</sup> August '20 in a phased manner and in batches.
  - Senior classes (9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> std) will start first and the junior classes will follow gradually.

#### 3. How the school will operate to maintain social distancing?

- Initially each class will come on alternate days. All Saturdays will be made full working days.
- Each class will be divided into 3 or 4 sections so as to accommodate a maximum of only 20 students in a class room and thus provide a social distancing easily.
- Two teachers will always be in a class room so as to maintain student discipline and the orderly behavior during recess, arrival and dispersal.
- Arrival and dispersal of students will be staggered to avoid crowding.

## 4. Will the school insist buying hand sanitizer, mask, gloves etc from the school only.

• No not at all! You have to provide <u>all the above</u> along with a soap for hand wash, a small towel to wipe hands etc.,

#### 5. When will the books and note books be issued?

• Already it is going on and the same had been communicated. Please visit our 'WEB NOTICE BOARD" for information on this.



#### 6. When we have to pay the school fees and what is the last date?

• Last date for fees payment was 4<sup>th</sup> May 2020. You can pay it on any working day between 10.00 am and 02.00 pm.

#### 7. What are modes of payment of tuition fee?

• Tuition fee can be paid by cash, credit/debit cards, online & by Demand Drafts.

#### 8. Can we pay the fees in two installments and finish it before July'20?

• We normally collect the fees in a single installment only. However if anybody is facing acute problems due to Covid-19, you can approach the Principal for his consideration.

# 9. Our children are very small (from KG to 3<sup>rd</sup> std), We are afraid of infection. Can we send them to the school for the next year by skipping this year class?

• This is a wrong perception/idea. Nearly 70% of the brain growth takes place between the age of 2 ½ & 8 years. Education is not only about writing and reading. It is also about learning socialization, Security, Diversity, Responsibility, Self-sufficiency, Good manners, Activity, Flourishing imagination of students, Regularity Discipline etc., Formation of Aptitudes and Attitudes of children happens only during this period. Therefore missing a school year is a completely misplaced concept and therefore needs to be discouraged tooth and nail.

#### 10. Will you conduct ONLINE classes?

- Online classes are being conducted for the classes from 6<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> standard.
- As per the Government's order no online classes can be conducted for Nursery and lower primary up to 5<sup>th</sup> standard by the school.
